We are incredibly privileged to welcome Dr Natasha Mayo.

Dr Natasha Mayo is a practitioner, researcher and since 2004 senior lecturer ceramics at Cardiff School of Art and Design. Her practice is fuelled by an interest in approaches that move between social, technical as well as creative ways of working. Teaching within an interdisciplinary framework she calls upon drawing, poetry, sensory anthropology, and relational aesthetics alongside more traditional approaches to clay – to test the boundaries and preconceptions of the discipline and to identify more wholistic generative approaches to creativity.

In ceramics she has achieved national and international acclaim with work in private collections in the USA, Korea, Japan, Belgium, France and most recently selected as part of the renowned ceramics archive at the International Ceramics Studio, Hungary. Her work revisits the focus of 'thinking through the skin' on the figure, an experimentation with the ceramic surface to convey a sense of knowledge as it travels through the body.

As recipient of the 2023 Ceramics Residency Award at the International Ceramics Studio, Hungary, Natasha will be talking about her extraordinary experience and encouraging others to make the journey.
